He has spoken at the annual meetings of the American Geophysical Union and the Geological Society of America.

What is Worldview Two?

When each of us makes plans and decisions, we use a framework or worldview that describes the world we are planning into. Most folks use what I call "Worldview One" – business as usual; tomorrow will be a lot like today and yesterday. "Worldview Two" is the concept that the emerging world will be much different, and we should prepare accordingly, embracing the uncertainty that this entails. Conference participants will share in both creating and understanding that new Worldview.
